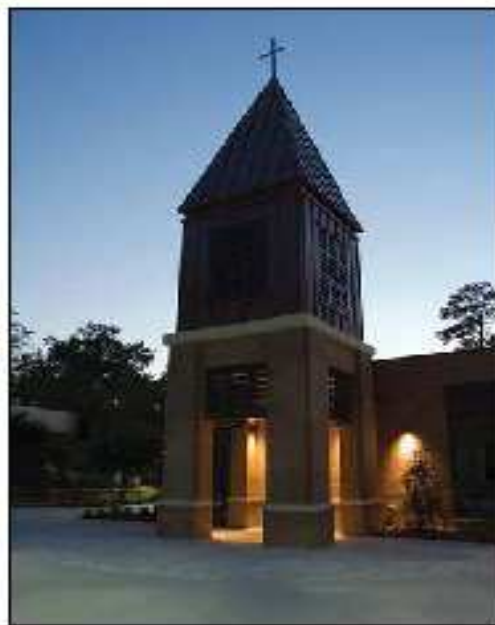

The Internet has become the new schoolyard for child molesters seeking girls or boys to victimize. Internet "chat rooms" provide a teenager with an opportunity to engage in a "live" conversation with friends from school or church, or with other teenagers from around the world. A chat room is similar to an old-style telephone party line, except that the teens are typing. Law enforcement has found that child molesters use chat rooms to gain easy and safe access to teens. Because of the seemingly caring and seductive talent of child molesters, teenagers should be warned that when they are in a chat room, they should never provide anyone with private information, personal information, and especially their specific physical location.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

Baptism—Baptisms can be celebrated after the 5:30 pm Saturday Mass or the 11:30 am Sunday Mass on the **SECOND** and **FOURTH** weekends of the month as scheduled through the church office. Attendance at a Baptismal Preparation Class and prior parish registration are required. Please register for the class you will attend by calling the office, 873-0631, ext. 10, by the Monday prior to the class. **The next Baptism class will be held on September 15th at Summerville Catholic School at 6:30 PM. The October class will be held on October 13 at Summerville Catholic School at 6:30 PM.**

Religious Education Classes - Grades K-4 - Grade 5 meet on Wednesday evenings beginning **September 15th**. Middle School Students meet 3 Sunday afternoons a month and High School Students meet Sunday evenings. All students must be registered, attending members of St. John the Beloved Parish to register in a sacramental preparation program. Students in Grade 2 and above can register for Reconciliation and Eucharist and Grade 8 and above for Confirmation. Copies of Baptismal certificates should be submitted at the time of registration. **Registration for Reconciliation-Eucharist classes and Confirmation will close following the first class.**

Children's Liturgy of the Word is celebrated during the 9:30 Mass for children in grade K-5 through Grade 5 every Sunday (except Easter) until the end of May, 2010. If you have questions, contact Sister Maryjane at 873-0631 ext. 16.

Matrimony—Please call the parish office for an appointment with Msgr. Lathem to begin the process at least six months prior to the anticipated date of marriage.

Anointing of the Sick—Please contact Msgr. Lathem to receive this sacrament prior to your hospitalization. Anointing is done following weekday or Sunday Masses.

Hospital Visits—The hospital cannot notify your church of your hospitalization. To receive Eucharist or a visit, please contact the church office or have a friend call us.
